## “Share the Ride”... to McCurdy School

We are planning for our first adult mission trip... heading to McCurdy School in Espanola, NM. During the week of October 16-22 we will be working on projects at McCurdy.

Each week our bulletin lists our church pastors and staff, but what does it say about our church's missionaries? **Quote: “Missionaries: Every Member of the Congregation”.** The members of our church who are going to McCurdy will be our ‘**Site Missionaries**’... those doing the actual work for God's ministry at McCurdy School. However, this mission trip needs the support of the entire congregation!

The **Site Missionaries** will need prayer support, as well as financial support for this

trip. **McCurdy Spiritual Missionaries** will provide prayers for the team's ministry at McCurdy and for their safe return to our church. We will also need to have members of the church willing to help the team raise money and gather materials for their trip. These will be our **McCurdy Service Missionaries**. This trip provides opportunities for our entire congregation to be involved!

One of the most important means of support for **McCurdy Site Missionaries** will be those that provide financial donations (or as the Bible says “talents”) to help with the cost of the trip. As with all mission trip there will be costs...bus, food and lodging (in

the dorm at the school). McCurdy asks that we also provide materials for a project that we will do while there. To offset these costs for the McCurdy Site missionaries, the Church Mission Team is going to have several fund-raisers.

The first is what we call the “**Share the Ride to McCurdy**” project. This will allow members of the church to give love offerings, and each dollar donated will equal one ‘share’ of the mission trip. Shares of the mission trip will be available starting Sunday, June 26 after both services, and will continue to be available any time after that!

Every member who gets at least five shares of the mission trip will

be considered **McCurdy Talent Missionaries**. These shares will be accumulated until October when they will be turned back to the Mission Team, and the shares will go on the mission trip to McCurdy with the **Site Missionaries**. These shares will be returned to the Talent Missionaries after the trip, signed by one of the McCurdy Site Missionaries.

Any member who accumulates 300 shares or more will be considered **McCurdy Associate Missionaries** because they will have provided funding for a significant portion of one McCurdy Site Missionary. In the end, everyone has the opportunity to participate in the McCurdy ministry.
