During October many clinics/hospitals/groups offer special rates so seek financial help if needed. Talk to your health care provider to determine at what age to begin/and follow up with mammograms. My yearly mammogram found my breast cancer while it was stage one. No

chemotherapy was needed after my surgery since it was caught in the earliest stage. It has been eleven years since my mammogram detected my lump.

When you see pink, ACT and schedule an appointment. Men, encourage your female loved ones to make an appointment.

Don't let October slip by without taking care of your breast health.

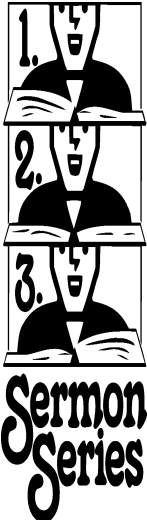

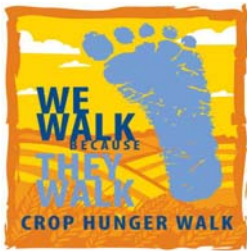
Do you enjoy Scrapbooking?
